





The Gorge Scenic Chairlift has been operating since 1972 and has become one of Tasmania's premier tourist attractions. Situated approximately 1.5km from the city centre, the chairlift offers spectacular views of the Cataract Gorge and Basin. With a total span of 457m, the 308m central span is the longest single chairlift span in the world. Ride the chairlift over the huge naturally formed basin, filled by the waters of the South Esk River to the Cliff Grounds. Your gentle breathtaking journey will provide you with stunning views of the majestic dolerite cliffs of the Cataract Gorge, which was described by William Collins, of the ship Lady Nelson, as "a scene of natural beauty, probably not surpassed in the world".

The Western bank of the Tamar River rewards visitors with a stunning riverside scenic drive, and a string of laid-back towns. Two of these towns are Beaconsfield and Beauty Point, which house three of the West Tamar's major attractions: Beaconsfield Mine and Heritage Centre, Seahorse World and Platypus House.

A Tamar Triple Pass enables the holder entry to all three of these attractions. At Beaconsfield Mine, visitors take a self-guided tour around the facility (bookings not required), while at Platypus House and Seahorse World, your pass gives you a place on a guided tour. Bookings are recommended but not essential on guided tours.

Make a full day of it on the West Tamar and visit all three, or use your voucher over consecutive days to suit your itinerary. Beaconsfield is located 40 minutes north of Launceston, the nearest gateway, with Seahorse World and Platypus House, just 5 minutes' drive further north.
